Refer IN protocol (Save/print for easy reference)

For cases that you would like to have Dr. Lara Rasmussen <u>come to your Twin Cities clinic</u> to perform outpatient surgery on one of your patients, please follow this protocol for preparations.

- Contact *Direct Veterinary Surgery, LLC* by website form, email, or phone. www.directvetsurg.com <u>directvetsurg@gmail.com</u>
- 2) Relay one of the following scenarios:

- a. Patient with firm diagnosis, need to set up surgery.
- b. Patient with **fuzzy** diagnosis, need a DVM <u>phone consult</u> to firm up options.
- c. Patient with **open** diagnosis, need to set up <u>consult</u>.
- 3) Provide 3-5 dates that are preferred.
- 4) Date will be confirmed (by original contact method—phone or email).
- 5) To avoid "medical cancelations", please have pre-anesthetic exam/bloodwork completed prior to surgery date.

BEFORE THE VISIT:

- A calendar reminder/confirmation will be sent to clinic, along with <u>educational material for the owners</u>
 (**please pass along to owners before surgery day **).
- Day before surgery, a phone confirmation to clinic with approximate arrival time. (**contact DVS if not received**)

DAY OF SURGERY:

- DVS will call clinic 30min before arrival. **Please do NOT induce anesthesia until this call!**
- DVS arrives and receives verbal patient history and diagnostics from primary care DVM on case.
- Dr. Lara Rasmussen will discuss options and confirm plan for visit with pcDVM.
- Dr. Lara Rasmussen will assist *staff* with patient preparations and request a *staff member* to call owner regarding timing of surgery start/stop.
- Primary care DVM & staff will manage anesthesia premedication through recovery; DVS to assist where requested.
- DVS will provide all surgical equipment and procedures.
- Primary care clinic will provide miscellaneous disposable supplies (syringes, bandage materials, etc), as indicated.
- DVS will provide ancillary pain medications, drains and bandaging supplies (bupivacaine, lidocaine patch, Tegaderm bandaid, limb bandage, close suction drains, etc) as indicated.
- Dr. Lara Rasmussen will complete on-site medical record, provide written postoperative instructions, and discuss
 case with owner by phone/in-person (as preferred by pcDVM).

AFTER SURGERY:

- DVS will contact your clinic by email day 2-3 postop to scout and assist with any questions.
- DVS will contact your clinic by email day 14 to scout and assist with any questions after client recheck.
- Postop radiographs or other data are welcomed by email or webform for DVS review and comment.
