## QUICK START GUIDE: Surgery for your Pet with Lara Rasmussen, DVM, MS, DACVS

- 1) Your pet is diagnosed with an injury or illness, and surgical treatment is recommended.
- 2) Your primary care veterinarian confirms the recommendation for surgery with Dr. Lara Rasmussen.

## For outpatient surgery recommended at your primary care veterinary clinic:

- 3a) <u>Your veterinarian schedules</u> surgery with *Direct Veterinary Surgery* and confirms dates with you.
- 4a) You prepare your pet for surgery.
- 5a) You bring your pet to your primary care clinic in the morning for admission for surgery.
- 6a) You confirm the surgery plan and sign an Informed Consent.
- 7a) Dr. Lara Rasmussen proceeds with the surgery plan, and advises you postoperatively of surgery findings, treatments, and expectations.
- 8a) Your pet is discharged by your primary care veterinary team in the afternoon/evening with verbal and written instructions.
- 9a) You manage your pet's postop recovery.
- 10a) You follow up <u>with your primary care</u>
  <u>veterinarian</u> according to instructions, for exams
  and testing.

## For outpatient surgery recommended at a Direct Veterinary Surgery-Partner Clinic in the Twin Cities:

- 3b) You schedule surgery with *Direct Veterinary* Surgery after your primary care veterinarian has confirmed a surgery plan with DVS.
- 4b) You prepare your pet for surgery.
- 5b) You bring your pet to the *DVS*-Partner Clinic in the morning for admission for surgery.
- 6b) You confirm the surgery plan and sign an Informed Consent.
- 7b) Dr. Lara Rasmussen proceeds with the surgery plan, and advises you postoperatively of surgery findings, treatments, and expectations.
- 8b) Your pet is discharged by *DVS*-Partner Clinic veterinary team in the afternoon/evening with verbal and written instructions.
- 9b) You manage your pet's postop recovery.
- 10b) You follow up <u>with your primary care</u> <u>veterinarian</u> according to instructions, for exams and testing.
